The Zeitlinger lab studies transcriptional regulatory networks in *Drosophila* development. The long-term goal of the research program is to identify predictive rules by which gene expression programs are regulated in an organism and apply them to human disease.

Available projects include, but are not limited to, investigating the relationship between chromatin status and development using ChIP-seq technology, as well as investigating the developmental role of RNA polymerase pausing using in vivo imaging.
